Instructions for Marriage/Civil Union Application (REG-15)

PLEASE CALL TO SCHEDULE AN APPOINTMENT **(856) 429-4482**

What you should bring with you, when you apply for a marriage/civil union license

1. If you are divorced or have had your marriage/civil union annulled, bring the divorce decree or the civil annulment documents.
2. Death certificate, if your former spouse is deceased.
3. Your birth certificate OR passport.
4. Drivers License or State ID showing your proof of residency.
5. Your social security card or social security number, as per NJSA 37:1-17.
6. A witness (18 years of age or older and can be a relative) who knows both the male and female applicants.
7. A \$28.00 fee. (Cash or Check)

Your social security number is not subject to Right to Know laws and will be kept confidential.

If any documents are in foreign language they must be accompanied by an English translation.

Where application shall be made:

1. If the applicants are residents of New Jersey, the application is to be made in the municipality where either or both applicants reside.
2. If one of the applicants is not a resident of New Jersey, the application is to be made in the municipality where the New Jersey resident lives.
3. If neither are residents of New Jersey, the application is to be taken in the municipality where the ceremony will take place.

Do not sign the marriage/civil union application prior to going to the Municipal Registrar. You must sign the application, while under oath, in the presence of the issuing authority.

There is a 72-hour waiting period between the filing of the application and the issuance of the license. This 72-hour waiting period begins at the time the application is filed with the local Registrar.

The application is valid for six (6) months from the date accepted. Only one license may be granted from an application. An expiration date of 30 days will be entered on your license when it is picked up at the Registrars office. If the license expires prior to being used, a new application must be made.

NOTE TO REGISTRAR - Applicants and witness should be told that taking a false oath constitutes perjury, which is punishable by a maximum fine of \$7,500.00.

NOTE 1. This is the permanent home and principal establishment to which, when absent, the applicant intends to return.

NOTE 2. Written consent of both parents is required for the marriage or civil union of any person under eighteen years of age. In addition, if any person is under sixteen, the consent of the parents must be approved in writing by a judge of the Superior Court, Chancery Division, Family Part. Consent of parents is required for the remarriage or reaffirmation of civil union of a minor previously married or joined in a civil union to the same partner in another state.

NOTE 3. When a remarriage or reaffirmation of civil union license is requested, indicate in Question 6 that the parties are already married or joined in a civil union. It is required that proof of the previous marriage or civil union be submitted to you. Common law marriages, which were legal prior to December 1, 1939, must be established by

affidavit showing the place and date of the common law marriage contract. The place and date of the previous marriage or civil union should be stated on both the application and the license. The seventy-two hour waiting period is waived. Consent of parents is required for the remarriage or reaffirmation of a civil union of a minor previously joined in a marriage or civil union to the same partner in another state.

NOTE 4. If both applicants are nonresidents of New Jersey, the application must be made in the municipality where the ceremony will be performed. Registrar should mark the license accordingly.

NOTE 5. The Registrar's review of a divorce decree, dissolution of Civil Union, or termination of Domestic Partnership, submitted with this application, in no way implies the validity of the submitted document. Such determination can only be made by a court of law.
